# LUMBEE HOMECOMING

## PARADE RULES 2023

The parade will line up on South Jones Street across from the Pembroke Elementary campus. All participants will enter via Deep Branch Road. The parade will begin on South Jones Street, take a left onto East Third Street continue through town, then take a left onto Braves Drive to exit the parade. (Next to SECU)

**All individuals walking in the parade must exit at College Sun-Do 701 West 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, at the corner of West 3<sup>rd</sup> Street and Normal Street. Please have your transportation awaiting your arrival.**

*Line-up begins at 8:00 am. Everyone should be in the parade lineup by 9:30 am*

1. The parade will line up from 8:00 am to 9:30 am on July 8, 2023.
2. After application submission, the numbered parade pass provided by LRDA must be displayed on the dashboard/shown to personnel working the parade entry point at the junction of Deep Branch Road and South Jones Street.
3. **ALL WALKING ENTRIES ARE LIMITED TO 10 PEOPLE.**
4. **Vehicles will be positioned in line as assigned on a first come first serve basis.**
5. Vehicles dropping off people participating in the parade will do so at the barrier set up by the Robeson County Sheriff's Department on South Jones Street across from Pembroke Elementary.
6. The parade will start promptly at 9:55 am and will maintain a speed of 3 mph
7. There will be no throwing of candy or any other object from any parade vehicles.
8. There will be no jumping on, or off, of any parade vehicles. Stopping to allow thoroughfare for trains and actual emergencies are the only acceptable reasons for stopping during the parade.
9. **ATVs, golf carts, and animals are not allowed in the parade.**

**The right to reject any entry is reserved by the sponsoring agency. Applicants will be notified accordingly.**
